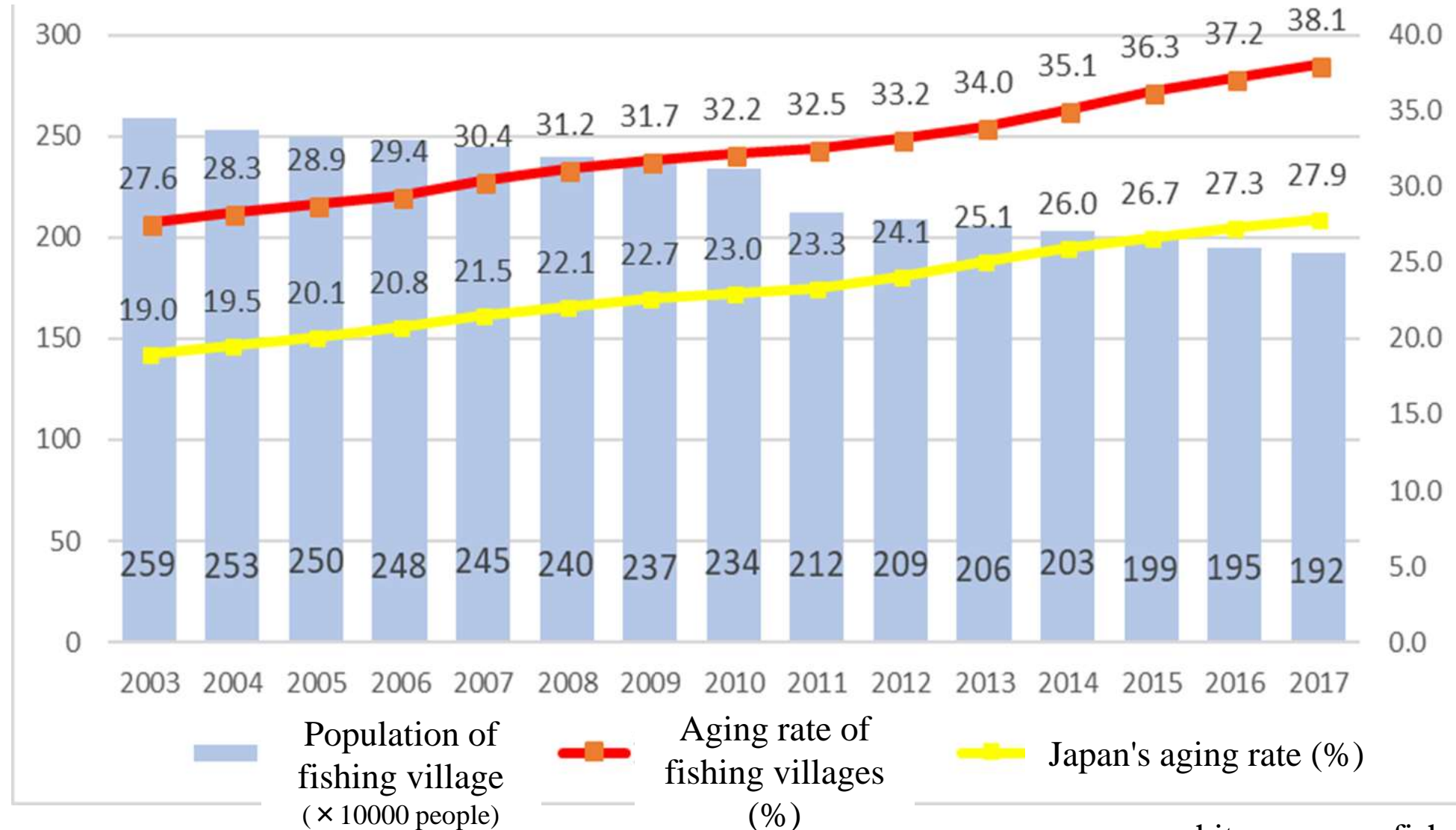

Changes in population and aging rate of fishing communities

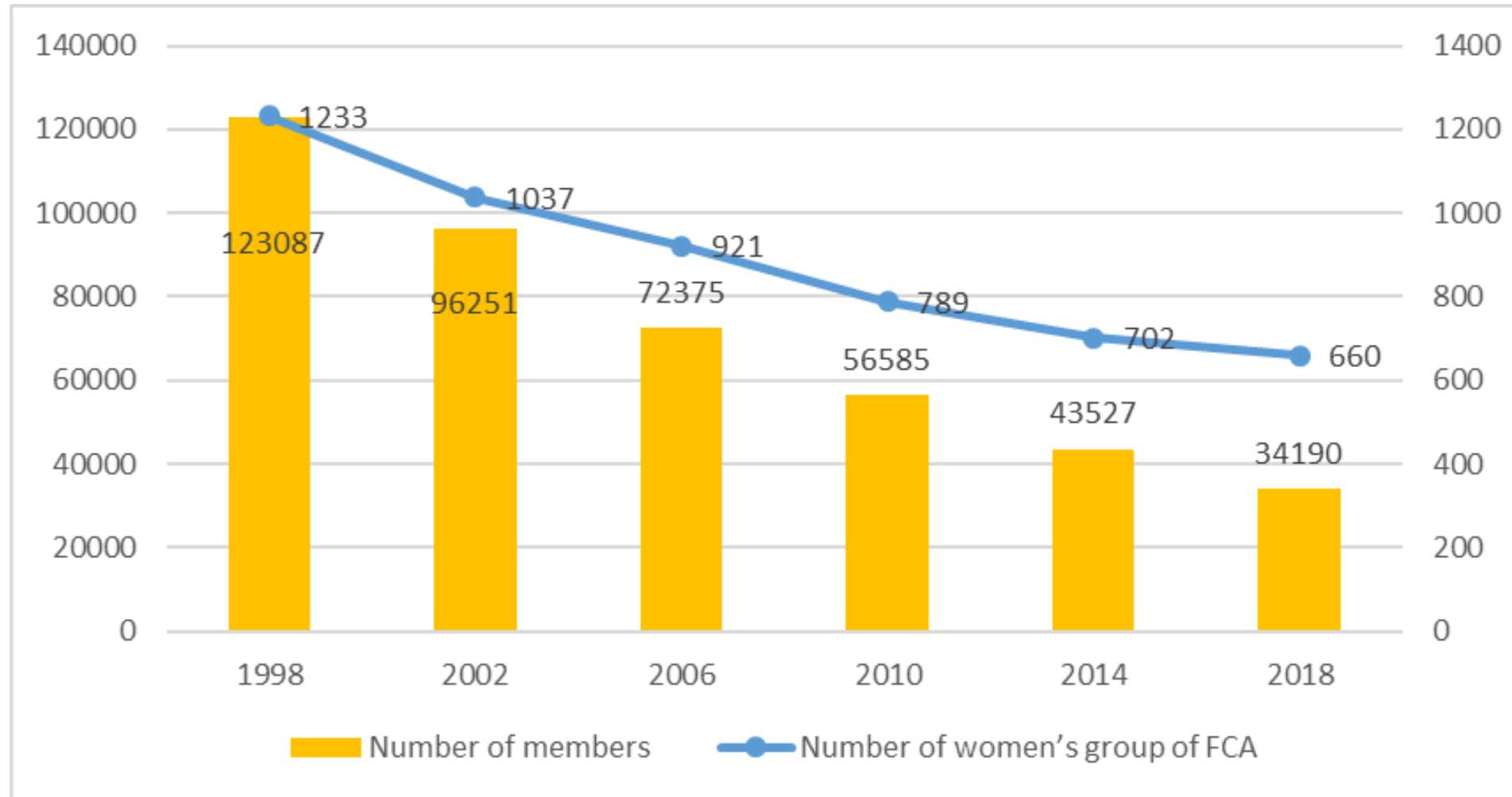

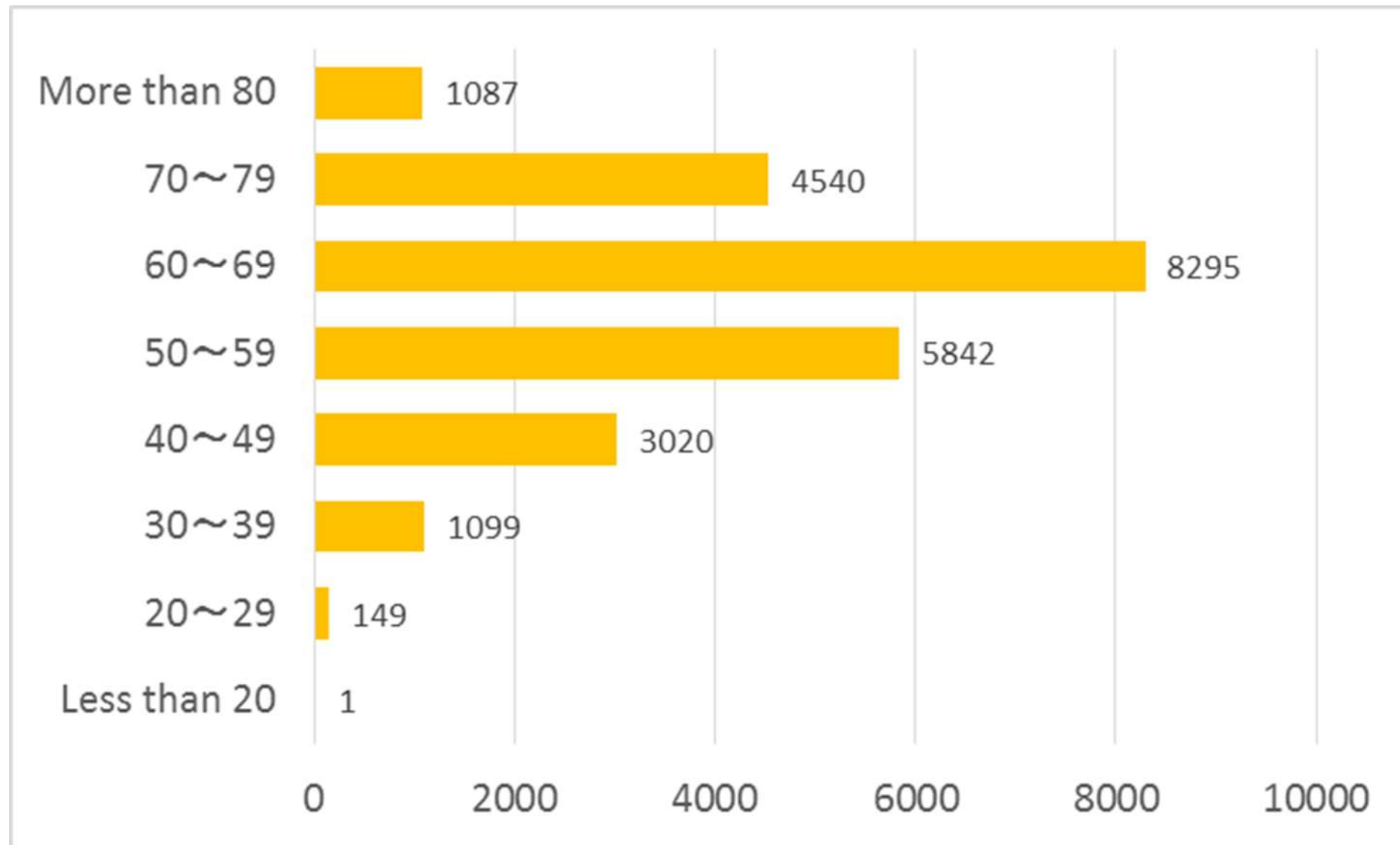

Trends in the number of woman's group of FCA and the number of members

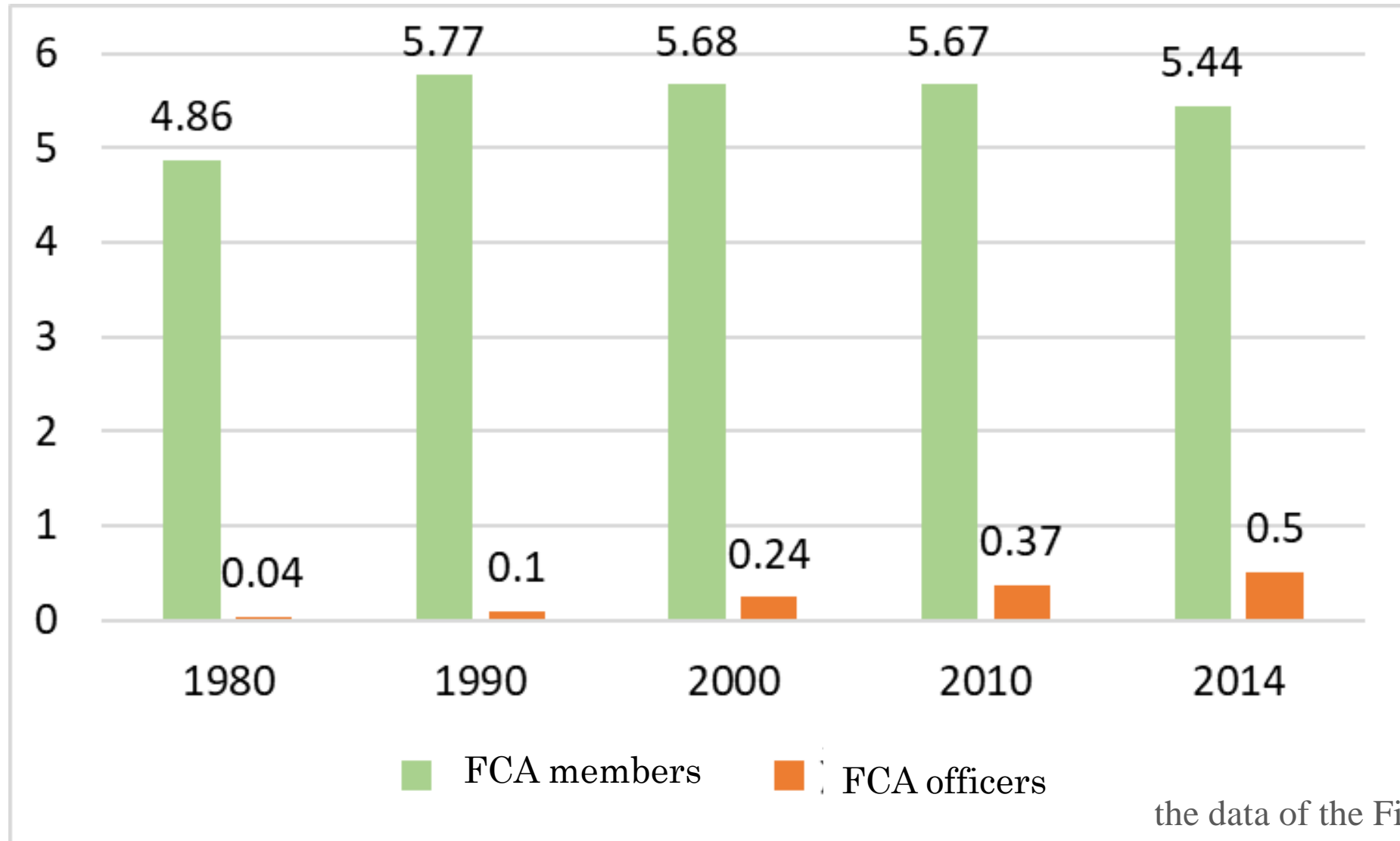
